**WELCOME** to Bee Tutored and I-consports's *SAT & TOEFL course!* We have prepared students for the SAT & TOEFL exams since 2007. Our program is geared towards athletes looking to obtain a sport's scholarship for University admissions. Unlike other test prep courses, we design our courses based around the individual needs of each student and will highlight the areas that admissions departments consider the most important on an international student's application.

## General Overview:

We have structured our one on one prep course to focus on General English Skills, SAT test prep, and TOEFL test prep, specifically focusing on developing critical reading skills for the Verbal section and reinforcing math related vocabulary to understand challenging word problems found on the Math section. Our one on one sessions are tailored to each student's individualized needs. His/her tutor will preform an assessment prior to getting started with the course and will create a plan of study specific to his/her needs of improvement. The recommended amount of tutoring will be based on your pre-enrollment assessment.

## About the exams:

The SAT does not test logic or abstract reasoning. It tests the skills you're learning in school: reading, writing and math.

- The **critical reading** section includes reading passages and sentence completions.
- The **writing** section includes a short essay and multiple-choice questions identifying errors and improving grammar and usage.
- The **mathematics** section includes questions on arithmetic operations, algebra, geometry, statistics and probability

The TOEFL measures your capacity to use and understand English at the university level. In particular the TOEFL will test your reading, listening, speaking, and writing skills. The course is divided according to the four sections of the test (**reading, listening, speaking, and writing**) with complete explanations on each section, realistic examples of all question types, and detailed advice to achieve maximum results. You will prepare with a mother-tongue teacher with a university degree who has experience teaching the TOEFL. *See page 3 for more detailed information on the TOEFL exam.*

## Class Information and Structure:

Your private tutor will discuss a pre-arranged schedule with you based on the package that is recommended to you by Bee Tutored. Your classes will be held online, via Skype at agreed upon day at a time that is convenient for your schedule. We understand that our student athletes have a very demanding schedule and should a conflict occur in scheduling, our tutors will happily work out an alternative day/time to make up any session(s).

All teaching classes will consist of the following:

- Homework review
- Post-exam review - after a practice test has been assigned
- Content review, exam strategy techniques, and in-class practice

**For 2016 graduates:**

2016 graduates will be encouraged to take at least 2 SAT exams in the Fall of 2016. Given that the colleges take the best scores presented to them, and that most SUPER-SCORE, meaning they take the best Math and combine with the best Reading, and Writing, it is advisable to take the SAT multiple times or until you have scored in the range accepted by your target schools.

**Bee Tutored's intensive course offerings for 2016 grads:**

### TOEFL Structure continued...

#### Section 1 – READING

- Evaluates the ability to comprehend and analyze various texts - approximately 700 words covering various academic subjects (anthropology, biology, art, economics, etc.)
- Evaluates student's vocabulary and understanding of synonyms
- Overall comprehension of the text and particular details

#### Section 2 – LISTENING

- Evaluates the ability of test-takers to understand main ideas, details, inferences, relationship between ideas, organization of the presented information, and as well as the speaker's attitude
- Includes 6-9 passages ranging from 3-6 minutes in length - generally, 2-3 student conversations and 4-6 academic lectures or classroom discussions
- Each conversation listening is followed with 5 questions; each classroom lecture and discussion is followed with 6 questions

#### Section 3 – SPEAKING

- Evaluates the ability to speak about a familiar topics and how well information is integrated from different sources
- Includes 6 speaking prompts - two independent tasks, which require a response (your opinion based on a familiar topic) and four integrated tasks
- You do not meet speak with a live examiner, but speak directly into a microphone (responses are recorded on the computer and then graded by two qualified evaluators)
- You are given from 45–60 seconds to record your response (45 for the two independent responses and 60 seconds for the four integrated questions)

#### Section 4 – WRITING

- Evaluates the ability to write effectively in the English language
- This is the last section of the TOEFL and lasts for about 60 minutes
- Consists of two different essays: the integrated writing task (20 minute time limit) and the independent writing task (30 minute time limit)
